



North Huon Cricket Club Code of Conduct

All North Huon Cricket Club members (players both cricket and 8-ball, supporters and officials) are to abide by this Code of Conduct, whether at training, games, official events, while in the clubs precinct or on other occasions while representing the club. (The club precinct is defined as the club premises and the surrounding playing, practice and supporter areas of the Ranelagh recreation ground, and the Glen Huon Oval).

All members must:

1. Abide by the Huon Channel Cricket Association (HCCA) policies, NHCC policies and rules which apply to their subordinate clubs. Teams participating in competitions governed by alternative associations must also abide by relevant policies and rules.
2. Not argue with officials. Any dispute or complaint may only be addressed through coaches or match managers and addressed via official Club channels.
3. Display self control at all times. Physical or verbal abuse of officials, other players, spectators or deliberately distracting or provoking a competitor is neither acceptable or condoned.
4. Work equally hard for each other, the team and the club.
5. Recognise all good performances whether or not they are by their team members or others.
6. Treat other members of the North Huon Cricket Club and opposing teams as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, bully or take advantage of another person.
7. Respect and follow the directions of coaching staff, match and or club officials. Also co-operate with team mates and others and carry out reasonable instructions from coaches, managers or committee.
8. Be ready to start training at the appointed time. If unavailable or late for training, players are required to notify coaches as early as possible.
9. Be appropriately dressed for training and for games.
10. Not consume alcohol during games or training or present to play or train in an intoxicated state.
11. If a player, must inform coaching staff or selection committee if they are unavailable to play a minimum of three days prior to the scheduled game.
12. Report ALL injuries or accidents immediately, to the coaching staff or team manager (for players) or committee (for others).

13. Pay all fees and or subs by the due date for payment. Failure to do so will result in players not being available for selection or restricted access to facilities for others.
 14. Not smoke in changing rooms, club rooms, club training venues or on the field of play. Smoking is restricted to designated areas.
 15. Conduct themselves at ALL TIMES in a manner (both on and off the field) that would bring credit to the club, especially when in club uniform or wearing other club identification.
 16. Avoid individual or collective behaviour, which may reasonably be held by others to be offensive.
 17. Avoid all acts likely to incite others to violence or disorder.
 18. Respect the facilities and equipment of the North Huon Cricket Club and opposing clubs. The NHCC committee has an expectation that all members will show a high level of decorum around the club precinct. This includes putting rubbish in bins, behaving in a sociable/friendly manner. There is also a policy of user pays for any damage done to the clubs property or clubrooms. Membership and or playing status of repeat offenders will be reviewed and potentially withdrawn.
 19. Not use remarks based on race, religion, gender or ability as many such comments are politically incorrect.
 20. Encourage participation but don't force it.
 21. Be aware that abusive language is unacceptable and will not be tolerated in the club precinct.
 22. Ensure that only committee members and Bar staff are permitted behind the bar or kiosk.
- Any misconduct will be dealt with by the North Huon Cricket Club Committee or Selection Committee. Penalties may be handed out to any member who is deemed to be in breach of the above Club Code of Conduct.
